## TOO LITTLE ON THE TABLE



The second nationwide round of negotiations for the chemical industry on 4/5 June also failed to produce any results. After two days of intensive talks lasting well into the night, both sides adjourned.

Chief negotiator Oliver Heinrich: "The employers presented us with many ideas - some of them can even be worked with. However, we are a long way from an overall package that is close to the demands! Obviously, the employers have moved so far away from the reality of their employees' lives that our members, their employees, must confront them once again unmistakably!"

# ACTION DAYS 18 & 19 JUNE

Our demands remain clear:

1. 7% increase in income for our members.
2. Collective agreements for the appreciation and betterment of our members
3. Modernisation of the federal collective wage agreement (*Bundesentgelttarifvertrag*) to create attractive development opportunities for our members.

There is movement on the employer side regarding the second central demand for a collective bargaining member benefit. Different variants have been discussed. Whether they will actually move remains to be seen.

We are calling on you to take part in the nationwide days of action on 18 and 19 June to emphasise your demands. Only when we were on the verge of breaking off the negotiations did the employers start to move!

more pressure to move forward.  
**Take part in the planned actions!**

Bad Breisig is the last chance to reach an agreement during the peace obligation (*Friedenspflicht*). The third round of negotiations at federal level is scheduled for 26 and 27 June in Bad Breisig near Bonn.
